RELEASE OF DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT

The Russian River County Sanitation District (RRCSD) has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) to assess potential environmental effects of their Equalization Basin Storage Project (Proposed Project).

The Proposed Project would result in the development of an earthen equalization basin and appurtenant structures within the existing boundaries of the RRCSD's Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP). The Proposed Project would consist of the construction, operation, and maintenance of an equalization basin that measures approximately 250 x 150 feet and has a nominal capacity of 3.5 million gallons. A pump station would be constructed adjacent to, or within, the equalization basin to pump the wastewater to the headworks (front end) of the WWTP as treatment capacity becomes available or as upset conditions are resolved.

RRCSD has established a 45-day review period which begins **August 15, 2007** and extends to **October 1, 2007**.
