

## Russian River County Sanitation District Ultraviolet Disinfection System Project Update

Dear Neighbor,

This notice is to inform you of some construction activities that will be taking place at the Russian River County Sanitation District's wastewater treatment plant located at 18400 Neeley Road. Beginning July 11, 2011, the District will be improving how it cleans our community's wastewater by constructing an ultraviolet disinfection system (UV Project). Based on the type of construction methods required to build the UV Project, we anticipate minimal traffic related impacts and no road closures on Neeley Road this summer. Construction will typically occur between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. during the weekdays. No road alterations will be made to Neeley Road. A majority of the construction activity will conclude in December 2011 with the overall UV Project slated for completion in August 2012.

The UV Project will reduce the use of chlorine needed to disinfect our community's wastewater and ensure the treatment plant meets California Code of Regulations, Title 22, requirements for reuse and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit requirements for river discharge.
