0	Existing Condition	~2-yr	Cost of maintenance
1a	Full 54" Pipe + Street Improvements (Curb, Gutter, Sidewalk)	100-yr	0.9 - 1.5M
1b	Full 54" Pipe + Smaller Channel	100-yr	0.8 - 1.4M
2	Trash Rack + Channel Improvements & Swale at Depot Park	10-yr	0.75 – 1M
3	Trash Rack + Channel Improvements at Depot Park	~10-yr	0.25 – 0.5M
