

HELP KEEP LAKE MENDOCINO OPEN TO BOATING RECREATION

DON'T MOVE A MUSSEL

A mandatory quagga/zebra mussel inspection and prevention program is being developed for Lake Mendocino and Lake Sonoma. Please help keep Lake Mendocino open for boating recreation by inspecting your boat for quagga/zebra mussels. Make sure your boat is dry before entering a waterway.

Quagga/zebra mussels ruin boats and waterways. Watercraft and equipment can move quagga and zebra mussels from infested waterways to uninfested waterways.

If spread, these mussels can:

- Encrust boat hulls, clog cooling systems, jam steering equipment
- Alter aquatic ecosystems, resulting in fewer native species and sportfish
- Litter beaches with sharp, foul smelling shells
- Clog water distribution systems, resulting in higher utility bills


