VOMWD Comments on the SCWA Water Supply Strategy Action Plan

1. Page 5, Table of Contents

Footnote title “Water Supply Strategy” to indicate as follows: Order of listing does not indicate priority.

2. Page 6, Strategy One – Address Dry Creek Summer Flows

Add another immediate action item to seek federal funding to carry out the Biological Opinion requirements on Dry Creek.

3. Page 11, Strategy Three – Evaluate Potential Climate Change Impacts on Water Supply & Flood Protection

Because of the costs and expenses required, this strategy should be eliminated, but may be added back at a future date when the basis for the modeling can be identified with sufficient clarity and certainty so as to eliminate the otherwise necessary speculation and assumptions.

4. Page 22, Strategy Ten – Overcome Organizational Fragmentation to Promote Efficiency of Water System Operations & Planning

Near term action three to study possible Water Agency governance structures be elevated to an immediate action since the survey of elected officials have already been authorized by the SCWA Board of Directors in fall 2009
