Job descriptions:

Environmental Educators (4 positions): Under supervision, develop and teach environmental education lessons to youth and young adults working for the Sonoma County Youth Ecology Corps. Each of the teaching modules will have specific, local, relevant hands-on education activities. The environmental educators will receive formal training from Water Agency educators and natural resources staff.

Community & Government Affairs, general (1 position): Work closely with staff on development of outreach materials, including press releases; update and maintain public affairs calendars, press clippings and public meeting list; help staff events, including the Water Agency's booth at the Sonoma County Fair; and update website and assist with social media campaign.

Community & Government Affairs, groundwater (1 position): Work closely with staff on outreach to Spanish-language speakers about the new Sustainable Groundwater Management Act, including developing an events calendar, tabling at events and meetings, and possible door-to-door outreach. Spanish-language fluency is required.
