

The City Council adopted Resolution 33-2009 on February 17, 2009, which calls for specific voluntary water conservation measures. This was well before SWRCB adopted WR 2009-0027-DWR. For public outreach, the City has posted a water conservation page (<http://www.ci.healdsburg.ca.us/index.aspx?page=28&recordid=173&returnURL=%2findex.aspx>) which includes a link to the resolution and voluntary measures. The City resolution actually calls for a more aggressive reduction goal of 20% below 2008 levels. The page is directly linked from the City's home page.

Here's the 2004/2009 diversion numbers (in million gallons) through June, which covers all of the City's water use:

	2004	2009	Reduction
April	72.54	56.49	22%
May	91.63	63.95	30%
June	103.61	74.09	29%
July	110.07	88.45	20%

Overall, the City's total diversions since April are down just over 25% from 2004.
