


# The Russian River Watershed

A **watershed** is the area of land that collects all of the rain and snow that falls within its boundaries and then drains it into a body of water. Every creek, river, lake, or ocean receives water from its watershed.

The **Russian River Watershed** is located in Mendocino and Sonoma Counties in northern California. The river is 110 miles long, and drains a land area of 1,485 square miles.

- Russian River Watershed Boundary


