ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

- 1. **NOTICE.** The Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District (“Owner”), a local district of the State of California, hereby gives notice that it will accept Bids for construction of the following public work:

Contract Number 71-712-7- #3

North Bay Water Reuse Program Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District Fifth Street East Recycled Water Pipeline Project

- 2. **DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF THE WORK.** The Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District’s Fifth Street East Recycled Water Pipeline Project consists of approximately 8,000 linear feet of recycled water mainline pipe, valves, appurtenances and service laterals. The pipeline begins at the intersection of Watmaugh Road at Shainsky Road and extends east to the intersection of Watmaugh Road at Fifth Street East. The pipeline then turns north on Fifth Street East and runs to the intersection with Denmark Street. At Denmark Street the pipeline turns west and runs to the back of Sonoma Valley High School campus. The Project includes an extension of the pipeline along Engler Street to the City of Sonoma’s Valley Oaks Park.
- 3. **ESTIMATED PROJECT COST RANGE:** \$1,800,000 to \$2,260,000
- 4. **REQUIRED CONTRACTOR’S LICENSE(S).** A California “A” contractor’s license is required to Bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract.

- 6. **PROCUREMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS.** Bidders may examine Bidding Documents at Owner’s Office. Bidders may obtain hard copies of Bidding Documents upon registration as a Planholder through Owner’s office and payment of a non-refundable fee of \$60 for each copy. Owner will accept cash or checks payable to “Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District.” Bidding Documents need not be returned to Owner. Bidding Documents contain a reduced set of Drawings. Bidders may arrange to obtain full-size Drawings from Digital Prints & Imaging, 375 Tesconi Circle, Santa Rosa, California, 95401, 707-546-0401, for an additional charge to be

paid directly to Digital Prints & Imaging. Electronic Bidding Documents are available on Owner's website.

7. FUNDING.

A. This Project is funded in whole or part under the:

1. California Department of Water Resources (DWR) Proposition 84 Round 2 Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) Implementation Grant Program; and
2. United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, The Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (Public Law 102 575, Title XVI; 43 USC 390h et seq) as amended by Public Law 111-11, Title IX, Section 9110(a). This Project Manual was prepared in accordance with the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, Assistance Agreement, as modified.

B. Davis Bacon Act requirements related to payment of prevailing wages, posting of notices, and certified payroll records apply to this Project.

C. Additional information regarding requirements related to funding sources is included in Document 01415 (Regulatory Requirements - Funding).

8. REQUIRED SITE VISIT

The Site is accessible to the public. Bidders shall visit and fully investigate the Site as a condition of submitting a Bid.

9. RESTRICTIONS ON SUBSTITUTIONS. As a limitation on Bidder's privilege to substitute "or equal" items, Owner has found that certain items are designated as Owner standards and certain items are designated to match existing items in use on a particular public improvement either completed or in the course of completion or are available from one source. As to such items, Owner will not permit substitution. Such items are: McCrometer, McPropeller MW500 or MZ500 Flow Meters; Vent-O-Mat, Series RBX Air Valves.

10. INSTRUCTIONS. Bidders shall refer to Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders) for required documents and items to be submitted in sealed envelopes for deposit into the Bid boxes , located at Owner's Office, and applicable times for submission.

11. STATEMENTS OF QUALIFICATIONS. Each Bidder shall be required to submit, in accordance with Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders) and Document 00450 (Statement of Qualifications for Construction Work), a Statement of Qualifications.

12. BID SUBMISSION. Sealed Bids will be received at Owner's Office (see paragraph 5) until 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 12, 2016 according to the clock in the main lobby. The Bid opening will be in accordance with procedures set forth in Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders).

13. BID PREPARATION COST. Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of preparing their Bids.

14. CONTRACT TIME. Work shall be completed within 210 Days from the date when Contract Time commences to run.

15. PAYMENT BONDS. In accordance with California Civil Code Section 9550, payment bonds as set forth in Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders) will be required from the successful Bidder.

- 16. REGISTRATION PURSUANT TO LABOR CODE SECTION 1725.5 REQUIRED.** All Contractors submitting a Bid for this Project, and any Subcontractors listed therein, must be currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. Owner requires proof of current registration by Contractor and all listed Subcontractors as a condition to Bid on this Project, subject only to the allowances of Labor Code section 1771.1.
- 17. PREVAILING WAGE LAWS.** This Project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. The successful Bidder must comply with all prevailing wage laws applicable to the Project, and related requirements contained in the Contract Documents. Copies of the state's general prevailing rates of per diem wages for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute the Contract, as determined by Director of the State of California Department of Industrial Relations, are on file at Owner's Office and are deemed included in the Bidding Documents. Upon request, Owner will make copies available to any interested party. Contractor shall post the applicable prevailing wage rates at the Site in addition to all other job site notices prescribed by regulations.
- 18. LABOR COMPLIANCE PROGRAM**
- A. Due to Proposition 84 funding for the Project, Owner is required to operate a Labor Compliance Program (LCP) pursuant to Labor Code sections 1771.5 and 1771.7. All Contractors and Subcontractors shall be required to comply with the LCP.
 - B. Additional information regarding requirements related to the Labor Compliance Program is included in Document 01416 Regulatory Requirements – Labor Compliance Program.
- 19. SUBSTITUTION OF SECURITIES.** Owner will permit successful Bidder to substitute securities for retention monies withheld to ensure performance of Contract, as set forth in Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention), in accordance with California Public Contract Code, Section 22300. By this reference, Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention) is incorporated in full in this Document 00100.
- 20. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS.** Owner specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all Bids, or re-bid, or to waive inconsequential deviations from Bid requirements not involving time, price, or quality of the Work.
