

# Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District Commercial Water Efficiency Program

Program/Rebates available on a first come, first served basis through June 30, 2010 while funding lasts.

## Save Water. Save Money.

The Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District Water Efficiency Rebate Program was established to help your business save water, lower operating costs, and reduce wastewater flows to your local wastewater treatment plant.

Upgrade your existing water using fixtures, equipment, and infrastructure and get cash rebates that will shorten the return on investment. Using less water often saves energy as well, making improvements more cost effective by lowering your energy costs.

## Direct Installation Plumbing Program

**FREE!** Direct installation of high-efficiency plumbing fixtures (toilets, urinals, faucet aerators, showerheads) for SVCSD commercial customers including commercial, industrial, and institutional properties, and multi-family residences with three or more units on a single water meter.

Contact a Participating Plumbing Contractor to determine eligibility and program details. The program includes:

- Replacement of at least one high-flush toilet (3.5 gallons per flush or more) with a high-efficiency toilet (1.28 gpf or less) from our Qualifying Model List or
- Replacement of at least one urinal (1.0 gallons per flush or more) with a high efficiency urinal (0.125 gpf or less) from our Qualifying Model List and
- Replacement of all high-flow faucet aerators to high-efficiency models (1.5 gallons per minute or less) and
- Replacement of all high-flow showerheads with high-efficiency models (2.0 gpm or less).



**Please Note:** SVCSD is authorizing the Participating Plumbing Contractors to provide and install high-efficiency toilets. Existing ADA toilets will be replaced with ADA toilets. However, we cannot cover upgrades from standard toilets to ADA toilets or any additional upgrades outside of the program scope.

## High-Efficiency Toilet and Urinal Rebates

Replace your own toilets and urinals and get up to **\$300\*** back on each new, qualifying high-efficiency toilet (HET) or urinal (HEU).

An **HET** uses, on average, 1.28 gallons per flush (gpf) or less – a minimum of 20% less than the standard 1.6 gpf toilets. Replacing toilets saves water and reduces wastewater without sacrificing performance.



An **HEU** uses 0.125 gallons per flush (gpf). Replace a 1.0 gallon per flush urinal and reduce water use by 87%.

## Water Efficient Ice Machine Rebates

Rebates of up to **\$600\*** are available for upgrading ice machines to new, water efficient models. Replace an inefficient ice machine with a new water-cooled ice machine that use 20 gallons per 100 pounds of ice produced or less to qualify.

## Water Efficient Equipment Rebates

Commercial High-Efficiency Clothes Washers (CEE “Tier 3”) - up to **\$125**

Connectionless Food Steamers - up to **\$200**

Medical Equipment Steam Sterilizers - up to **\$700**

Dry Vacuum Pumps - up to **\$250**

Pressurized Water Brooms - up to **\$700**

Cooling Tower pH Controllers - up to **\$1,500**

Cooling Tower Conductivity Controllers - up to **\$5,000**

Sustained Reduction - Rebate based on water savings through permanent equipment upgrades.

**How to Participate**

1. Read and understand the Program Eligibility and Rules.
2. Determine if your commercial property is connected to Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District – look on your property tax bill for a line item stating the sanitation district you are connected to or call (707) 547-1968.
3. Contact the Water Efficiency Rebate Program at (707) 547-1968 to get pre-approval for your project.
4. Purchases and install your qualifying high-efficiency fixtures and equipment.
5. For clothes washers, complete and sign the application form below and mail along with **original** purchase receipts/ plumbers invoices to:

6. For other equipment, call for a post-inspection.
7. Please allow 6 to 8 weeks to process your rebate requests. Checks will be mailed to the address provided below.

**Program Eligibility and Rules**

1. Rebates are available April 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 while funding lasts.
  2. Your commercial property is connected to Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District.
  3. Your new fixtures and equipment have been installed and your rebate application is received or postmarked within 90 days of purchase or delivery. All purchases must be made between April 1, 2009 and June 30, 2010 to be eligible.
  4. Incomplete applications and those without original purchase receipts will be returned.
  5. For High-Efficiency Clothes Washers:
    - Your new clothes washer is a “Tier 3” model as listed on the *CEE Clothes Washer Qualifying Product List*.
    - Your old clothes washer was properly recycled or disposed of.
- \* Rebate amount can not exceed the cost of the new fixtures and/or equipment excluding sales tax, delivery, installation or other fees, costs or accessories.
